

Media Event Policy

The National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges (NCJFCJ) welcomes media interest in our events and conferences. We will aim to accommodate media as much as we can.

Our conferences, summits and institutes are open to the media, and all other meetings are closed. Certain networking and social functions may be open to the media – we ask that you contact our communications staff for more information. The NCJFCJ values and encourages an educational safe space for all participants and kindly requests all media personnel to follow the outlined protocol.

With prior NCJFCJ communications staff review and approval:

- Requests for attendance and RSVPs should be made 30 days prior of the event, and name badges/lanyards should be worn at all times during the event.
- Television crew and reporters can film and interview attendees, with their consent, and with prior arrangement and approval from the communications staff.
- NCJFCJ welcomes social media posts. We prefer that we review the posts prior to posting. Any abuse of this privilege will lead to refusal of access to the remainder of the event, and future events.
- Recording speakers is also permitted with prior approval and disclosure to participants before the event.
- Follow-up materials after the event can be requested from the communications staff.
