Compendium of Third Party Transfer Forms



Firearms Technical Assistance Project

In many jurisdictions, individuals subject to prohibitions on possession of firearms and/or orders to surrender them can simply transfer their firearms to a third party while retaining their ownership of the weapons. Even where such transfer is permissible (which is not true in all jurisdictions; in some, surrender of firearms must be to law enforcement or to a federally licensed firearms dealer, or "FFL"), regulation of the process is necessary to ensure that the prohibited person does not have access to the firearms and that the third party is eligible to possess them under state and federal law.


The components of a safe and effective third-party transfer system include:

- Initial surrender of firearms to law enforcement or an FFL, with a subsequent transfer to a third party permitted only by court order;
- A third-party acknowledgment form/affidavit signed by respondent and third party;
- Requirement that the third party appear in court and receive court admonishment regarding the third party's responsibilities and potential criminal liability for allowing the prohibited party to access the surrendered firearms; and
- If possible, a requirement that all transfers to third parties be conducted through law enforcement or an FFL, including a pre-transfer background check of the third party to ensure they are not prohibited from possessing firearms themselves.

This compendium provides examples of third-party transfer acknowledgment forms/ affidavits, for potential adaptation by communities developing their own process and forms. Please note that the compendium is like a menu of options; you should read through the examples and decide on language that fits your local process and statutory authority. Not all of these examples are applicable to every jurisdiction.

Full and timely compliance with orders to surrender firearms depends upon the prohibited person's understanding of how and where to relinquish the weapons, what proof of surrender is required, and the deadlines for both surrender of the firearms and for submitting the proof to the court. Courts should take all necessary steps to ensure that people subject to surrender orders receive and understand this information. Judges should provide the information orally in court, and prohibited persons should be given plain-language instruction sheets with all relevant information to ensure compliance with a safe surrender process.

NOTICE TO THIRD PARTY RECEIVING FIREARM(S) SEIZED PURSUANT TO A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDER

I hereby acknowledge that I have been informed that the firearm(s) I am receiving were seized in a domestic violence case. I understand that the defendant or respondent,, in this matter is no longer allowed to own, possess or have access to any firearms or
matter is no longer allowed to own, possess or have access to any firearms or ammunition.

In addition to any penalties prescribed in 23 Pa.C.S. Chapter 61 or 18 Pa.C.S. Chapter 61, I may be civilly liable to any person for any damages caused and shall be liable to any person for punitive damages in an amount not to exceed \$5,000. I understand that all firearms, other weapons, and ammunition relinquished to me for safekeeping will be stored using a locking device (relating to firearms) or in a secure location to which the defendant does not have access. I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that the facts that I have set forth in this form are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. This verification is made subject to both the penalties of Section 4904 of the Crimes Code (18 Pa.C.S. 4904) relating to unsworn falsification to authorities and the Uniform Firearms Act. I also understand that the making of any false written statement or the exhibiting of any false misrepresented identification with respect to this application is a crime punishable as a felony. Section 6105(a):

Effective November 22, 1995, 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(a) prohibits persons convicted of any of the following offenses under 18 Pa.C.S. from possessing, using, controlling, transferring, manufacturing, or obtaining a license to possess, use, control, transfer, or manufacture a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. A conviction includes a finding of guilty or the entering of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere, whether or not judgement has been imposed, as determined by the law of the jurisdiction in which the prosecution was held. The term does not include a conviction which has been expunged or overturned or for which an individual has been pardoned unless the pardon expressly provides that the individual may

Section 6105(c):

Effective November 22, 1995, 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(c) also prohibits the following persons from possessing, using, controlling, transferring, manufacturing, or obtaining a license to possess, use, control, transfer, or manufacture a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

ARE YOU A PERSON WHO:

- is a fugitive from justice; or
- has been convicted of an offense under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or any equivalent Federal statute or equivalent statute of any other state, that may be punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding two years; or
- has been convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol or controlled substance as provided in 75 Pa.C.S. § 3802 (relating to driving under influence of alcohol or controlled substance) or the former 75 Pa.C.S. § 3731, on three or more separate occasions within a five-year period. For the purposes of this paragraph only, the prohibition of Section 6105(a) shall only apply to transfers or purchases of firearms after the third conviction; or
- has been adjudicated as an incompetent or who has been involuntarily committed to a mental institution for inpatient care and treatment under section 302, 303, or 304 of the provisions of the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L. 817, No. 143), known as the Mental Health Procedures Act; or
- being an alien, is illegally or unlawfully in the United States; or
- is the subject of an active protection from abuse order issued pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S. § 6108 (relating to relief), which order provides for the relinquishment of firearms during the period of time the order is in effect. This prohibition shall terminate upon the expiration or vacation of an active protection from abuse order or portion thereof relating to the relinquishment of firearms; or
- was adjudicated delinquent by a court pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 6341 (relating to adjudication) or under any equivalent Federal statute or statute of any other state as a result of conduct which if committed by an adult would constitute an offense under 18 Pa.C.S. sections 2502, 2503, 2702, 2703, 2704, 2901, 3121, 3123, 3301, 3502, 3701, and 3923; or
- was adjudicated delinquent by a court pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 6341 or under any equivalent Federal statute or statute of any other state as a result of conduct which if committed by an adult would constitute an offense enumerated in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105(b) with the exception of those crimes set forth in paragraph 7. This prohibition shall terminate 15 years after the last applicable delinquent adjudication or upon the person reaching the age of 30, whichever is earlier.
- is prohibited from possessing or acquiring a firearm under 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(9) (relating to unlawful acts) who has been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence by a person in any of the following relationships: (i) the current or former spouse, parent or guardian of the victim; (ii) a person with whom the victim shares a child in common; (iii) a person who cohabits with or has cohabited with the victim as a spouse, parent or guardian; or (iv) a person similarly situated to a spouse, parent, or guardian of the victim; then the relationship need not be an element of the offense to meet the requirements of this paragraph.

(18 U.S.C. §922 (g)(8) prohibits persons subject to a court order that restrains them from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner or child of an intimate partner.)
